






### Conada Barometer Rising

#### **Attractiveness of Study Destinations in 2012**










### Comada Barometer Rising

- Test format: 42 multiple choice questions in 80 minutes
- Candidates with a minimum of 80% correct answers pass the test

- Candidates successfully passing the exam will obtain the status of "Canada Course Graduate" (CCG)






