

3-YEAR UPDATE ON THE ECONOMIC IMPACT OF INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

The International Education sector continues to grow in BC. The numbers below are based on The Economic Impact of International Education report commissioned by BCCIE from Roslyn Kunin & Associates based on the number of international students in BC in 2009-10, compared with the number of international students in BC in 2012-13.

ECONOMIC CONTRIBUTIONS TO BRITISH COLUMBIA

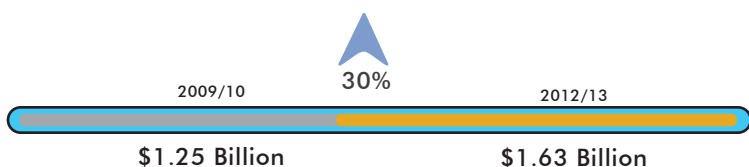

International students make up a large and growing contribution to the economy of BC. Their total spending contributes over \$2.3 billion to the provincial economy.

DIRECT CONTRIBUTION TO PROVINCIAL GDP



The sum of international student spending in BC translates into \$1.63 billion in provincial GDP, a \$380 million increase compared to 2009/10.

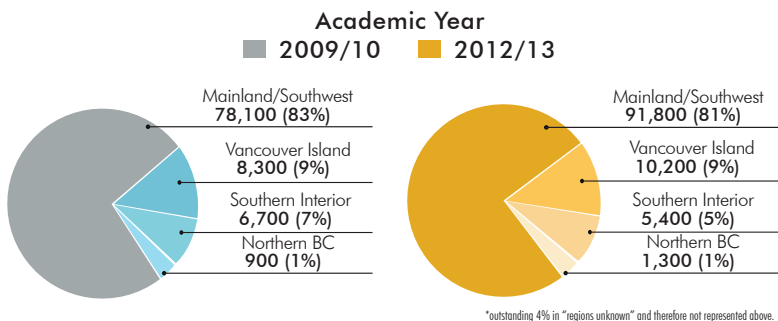
INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IN BC

WHERE ARE INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IN BC?

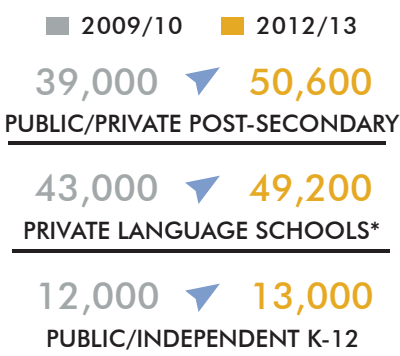


BY SOURCE COUNTRY
