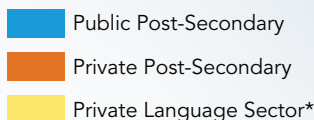


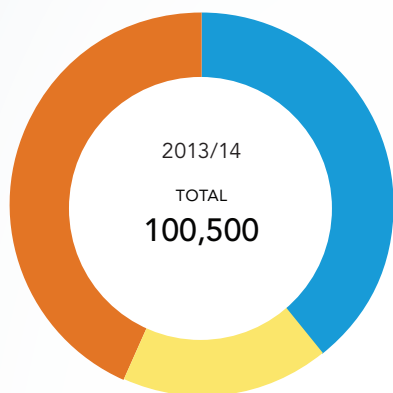
ECONOMIC IMPACT OF INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION IN BRITISH COLUMBIA

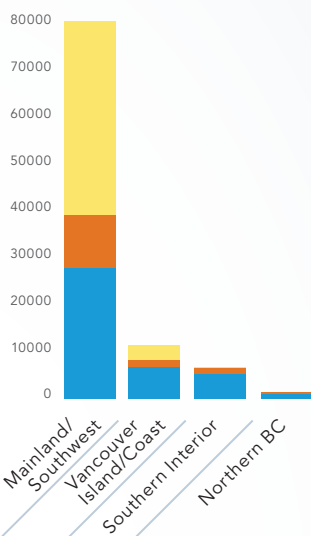

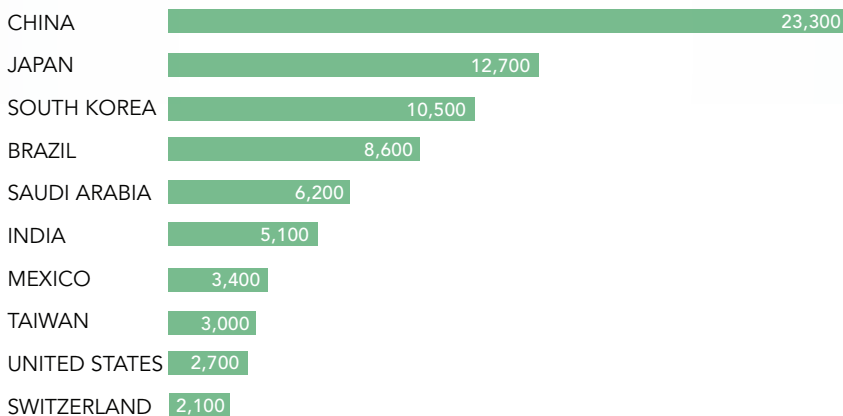
POST-SECONDARY AND PRIVATE LANGUAGE INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IN BC



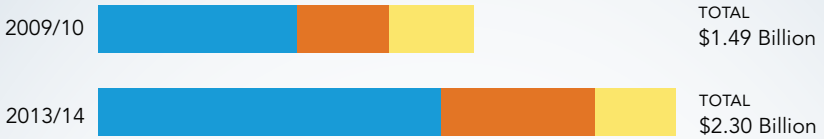
