Some trends in #HigherEd

- Growing importance of internationalization at all levels
 - Internationalization Abroad: mobility (degree, short term, language, student/faculty)
 - Internationalization at Home: campus, curriculum, teaching & learning, joint programs, intercultural competences
- Competitive pressures of globalization, global rankings
- Global issues influencing the strategic development of HEIs
 - ✓ From "International Relations" to "Internationalization Strategy" to "Global Engagement"
 - VP International, VP Global, etc.
 - Branch campus openings
- Globalization of Internationalization:

In the current global-knowledge society, the concept of internationalization of higher education has itself become globalized, demanding further consideration of its impact on policy and practice as more countries and types of institution around the world engage in the process (DeWit & Jones, 2014)













Some Consequences

- Numbers rising everywhere, with challenge of quantity versus quality
- Institutional strategies tend to be limited on:
 - Mobility
 - **Economic Gain**
 - Talent Recruitment
 - **International Positioning**
- Far greater efforts needed to:

 - Incorporate approaches into more comprehensive strategies
 Focus on internationalization of curriculum and learning outcomes to enhance quality of teaching and research
- Need to diversify
 - HEIs relying on internationalization to remain relevant
 - Risks of concentration
 - UAE vs Canada case
 - Australia vs China case
 - How about working with our neighbours?


