

CRISIS & RISK MANAGEMENT

Centralized communication protocols; professional response contractor; network of local ISEP coordinators

STUDENT PREPARATION

Dedicated student advisors supplement your staff; online resources; predeparture webinars; alumni and peer advice

UNDERREPRESENTED STUDENT SUPPORT

Student success initiative; internal diversity task force; student blogs; ISEP scholarships

ACADEMIC QUALITY

Accredited, high quality member institutions; membership governance; international ISEP Board of Directors; agreed upon standards

CURRICULUM INTEGRATION

Training; collection of syllabi; online search engine tools

RISING COSTS

Cost neutral exchanges; low cost direct-enrollment programs; hybrid faculty-led pilot program

Recently Added Opportunities

- Faculty-led / custom programs
- Credit-bearing Internships: research and career preparedness.

- USA Direct Enrollment Program
- Certificate Program in Italy
- ESL teaching placements in Costa Rica

SERVICE LEARNING

- Going beyond the academic programming to provide a holistic growth experience.
- Leveraging existing service opportunities at our member institutions (e.g., community service programs at Mexican institutions).
- ISEP-facilitated community engagement opportunities enable students to apply in real-life situations.
- Service provides a layer of immersion that the academic experience does not.

FACULTY-LED & CUSTOM PROGRAMS

- Matching the needs of one institution with the resources of another. No need to go outside of network.
- Collaborative short-term programs that capitalize on the existing resources at member institutions.
- UMBC-Bristol (history, political science), WCU-Caen (language and culture).
- Promotes further collaboration on research and faculty-exchange.
