



CANADA EDUCATION FAIRS **BARBADOS & ST. LUCIA**

The Student Centre, in collaboration with the Canadian High Commission in Bridgetown, Barbados will be hosting **CUP FEST 2015 - Canada Education Fair Edition** from October 17 -18, 2015 **in the island of Barbados** and October 20-21, 2015 **in the island of St. Lucia**.

This exciting customized thematic event seeks to attract K-12, College and University bound students interested in studying in Canada. Visitors to fairs of this nature usually comprise of students, parents, teachers, guidance counsellors and other interested persons over each two day period. These Education Fairs have always proven to be an excellent forum for personal interaction with potential students and parents alike, and an effective recruitment exercise.

Venue

The venue for this year's Fairs will be:

Barbados: The Lloyd Erskine Sandiford Centre
St. Lucia: Bay Gardens Hotel

Format

The Barbados leg will take the format of a visitor facing fair with an open schedule for both days. Lunch will be staggered to allow the fair to remain open to visitors.

The first day of the St. Lucia fair will involve a bus tour to the south of the island, where exhibitors will meet with students from schools in the south, who do not have the opportunity to visit the fair in the north. A packed lunch will be provided on this day. The second day will take the format of a visitor facing fair with an open schedule.

Registration Fees

St. Lucia Only - \$600.00 CAD
Barbados and St. Lucia - \$1,100.00 CAD

Registration Enhancements

Half Hour Presentations \$150.00 CAD (Limited slots available) – Exhibitors can book a 30 minute seminar slot during fair hours in a seminar room, for the visiting public. A screen and data projector will be provided; however presenters must bring their own laptop. The seminar times and institutions will be published on the website and in the fair guide and booklet. There



are limited time slots and they will be allocated on a first-come basis. There are no concurrent seminars.

Special Advertising in Booklet \$250.00 CAD – Every institution will have a free profile in the fair booklet; however, for extra visibility, you can book a full colour ad. Artwork must be sent in print-ready format (jpg or pdf) by September 4, 2015, for placement in the fair booklet.
