Located in downtown Victoria, the school has a current capacity of 250 full-time students (170 in the shoulder season and 250 in the peak season). The school's programs are primarily directed at students aged 16 years and over. GV Victoria runs full-time language classes at eight (8) levels in General English as well as specialized full-time classes in IELTS Exam Prep, Cambridge FCE & CAE, Business English and Power Speaking.

At various times of the year, the school also runs programs for teens and adults in special interest pursuits. GV Victoria prides itself on a positive learning atmosphere and also arranges accommodation and activities for students, so that they can experience Canadian culture and recreational opportunities in a great social and natural environment.
