- Why are you applying for the BCSA scholarship?
- What do you hope to learn from your study abroad program?
- How you plan to share your new knowledge once you are finished your program?

Sample of something you have written that is between one and five pages long (e.g., blog post, creative writing piece, essay, etc.)

You're also encouraged to send additional materials to support your application, such as photos, past blog entries, videos, etc.
