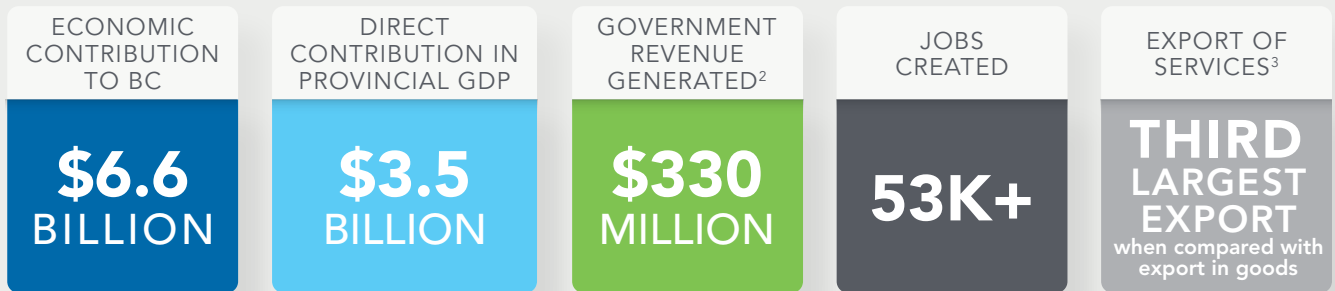


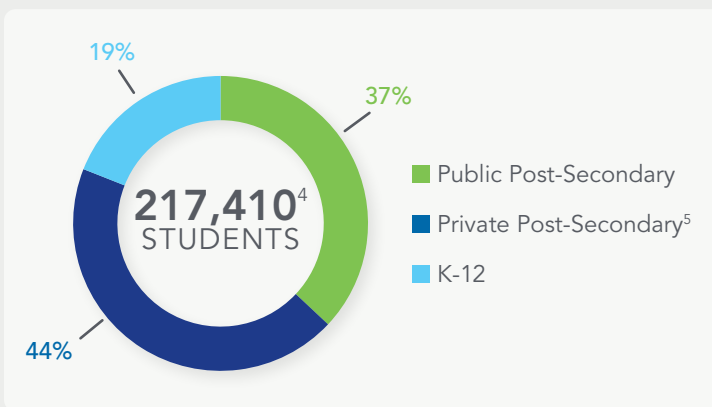

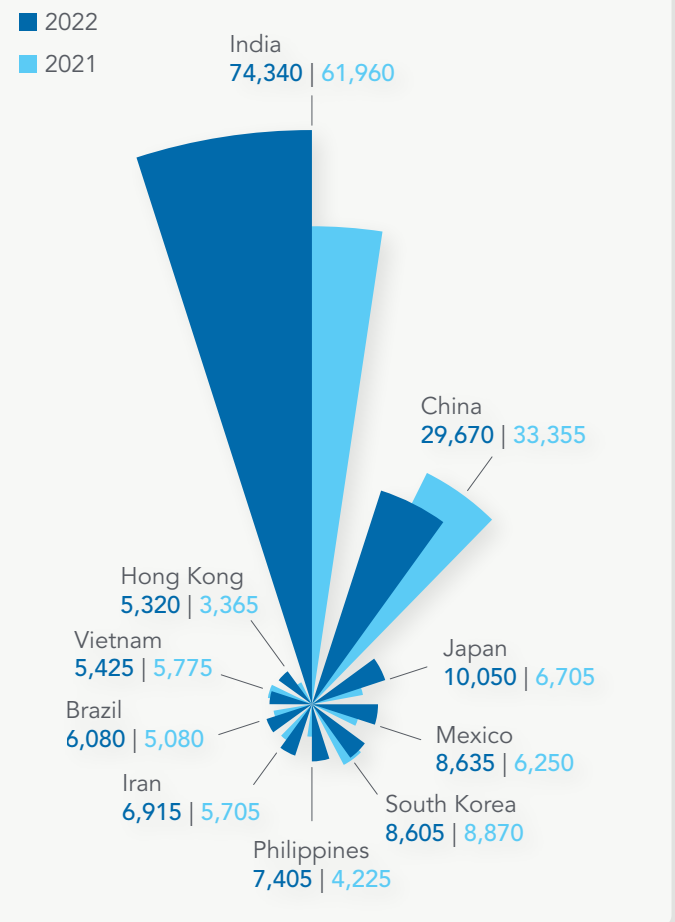

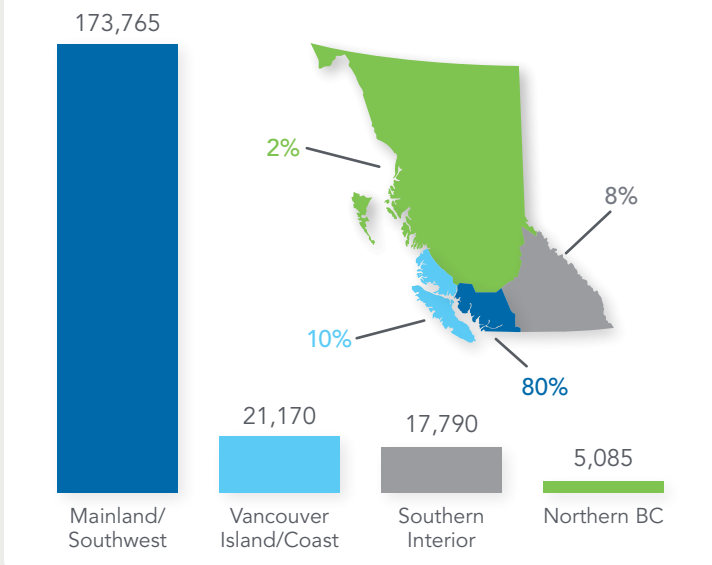
INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS IN BC IN 2022
