



Taiwan Experience Education Program (TEEP)

Taiwan's Ministry of Education launched the Taiwan Experience Education Program (TEEP) to encourage more international students to participate in short-term professional internship projects organized by Taiwanese universities and colleges. TEEP also allows international students to gain an in-depth educational experience in Taiwan, while also preparing themselves for the Asian job market. An increasing number of outstanding universities and colleges in Taiwan now offer TEEP@AsiaPlus - short-term professional and research internship programs for 500+ per year outstanding international youths to experience Taiwan's quality higher education and make personal connections in the Asian job market.

TEEP programs are also available in emerging fields such as Information Communication Technology (ICT), Internet of Things (IoT), Blockchain Technology, Semiconductors, 5G Wireless Communications, Advanced Manufacturing, Smart Manufacturing, Robotics, Green Energy, Biosensors, Logistics Management, Molecular Biology and Smart Health Care, as well as Mandarin Language Training or Cultural Experience Courses.

In 2024, 368 TEEP projects have been submitted by 54 universities and granted by the MOE. Among these projects, 106 are open for Canadian students to apply.
