As part of the International leadership team, the incumbent is the champion for identifying and developing new strategies and opportunities to successfully engage departments, faculty, and domestic as well as international students in all phases of the international teaching or learning experience. The Director works closely with Deans and Directors at Douglas College along with international partner institutions, the Consular Corps of B.C. and other organizations to advance the growth and quality of international engagement at the College.

This is an exciting opportunity for a passionate, energetic, and innovative international student services leader with deep knowledge of post-secondary global engagement best practices and opportunities. The ideal candidate will have a graduate degree combined with a minimum of seven (7) years of experience including at least five (5) years of internationalization experience in the Post-Secondary Education sector. The preferred candidate will have strong interpersonal, communication, and project management skills, including direct experience implementing international agreements and relevant services. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
