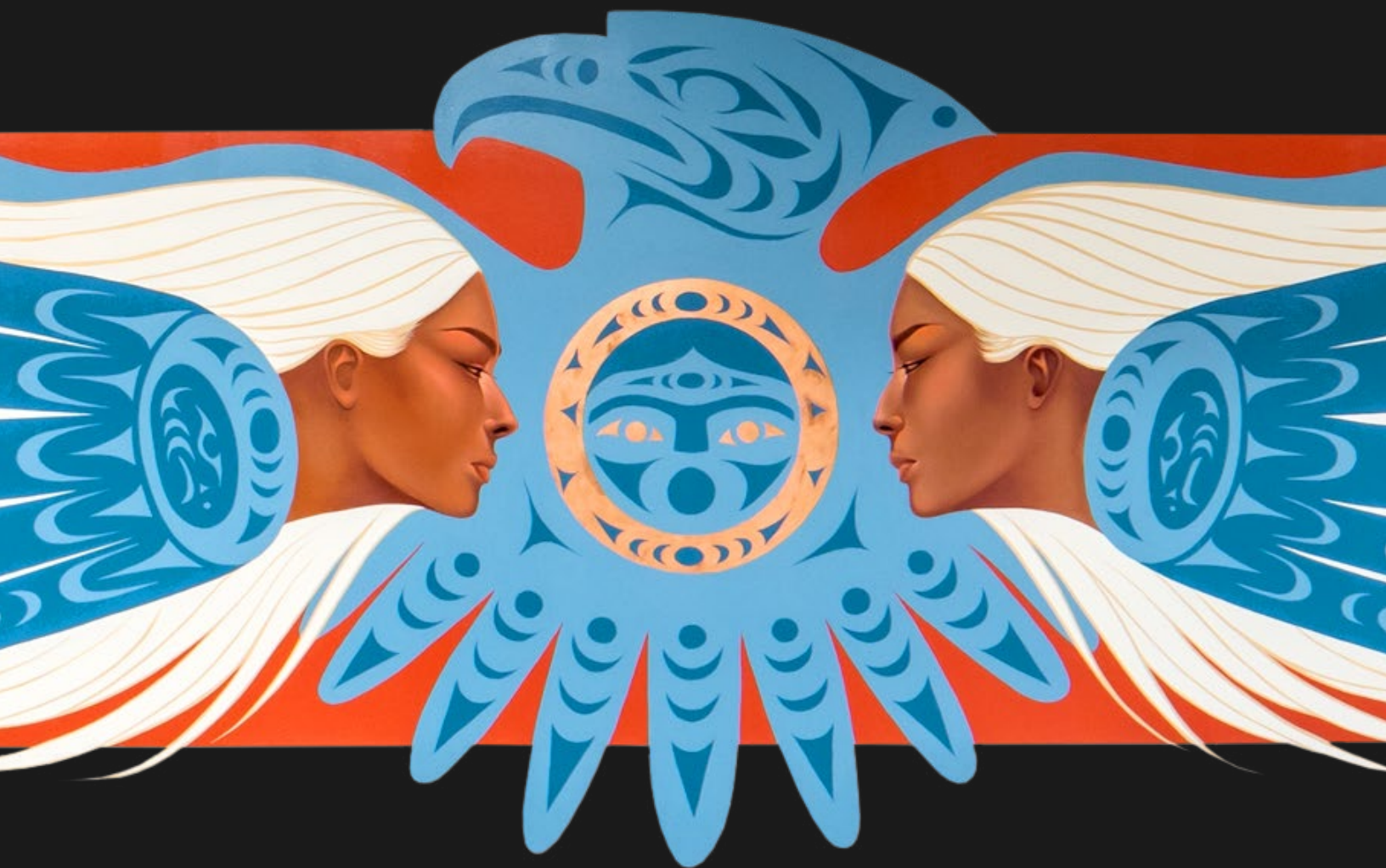
You have graduated with a PhD in a related field in the past ten years, demonstrating exceptional promise and potential for scholarly achievement.
